In the next picture I am preaching in the hospital waiting area at 0630. The Muslim lady has in her hand the tract "Big Daddy" which addresses the lie of evolution. She read the tract, she listened to the preaching, she then was discussed the whole thing with her neighbor seated next to her.

came to church. After the service he wanted to talk. So Br. Sutek and I talked with him and reasoned with him out of the Scriptures. He wanted help to escape the wages of sin. He knew he was going to hell because of his sin. We showed him how to be saved and he prayed in his own words and cried out to the Lord Jesus Christ, all glory to God! Please keep him in prayer to grow in the Lord.

Learning and dealing with the culture: Summer break for the schools is April and May. This is the hot and dry season, or the hotter and not as much rain season. There is a sign down the road that reads, "Live intimately with rain." My idea is that it should say, "Live intimately with sweat." Some days are 2 shower days, some are 3. It is nothing to go out in the morning to minister, come home drenched in sweat and take a shower. Do some chores a couple hours later, take a shower. Go teach at the institute, go preach and be soaked in sweat again. We have adapted and learned to deal with it. Praise the Lord! The joy of the Lord is my strength. That is what sustains us. "Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and he shall sustain thee." (Psalm 55:22a) That, and the prayers of our friends and supporters.
