A young lady named Elgrace, a friend of one of the teachers at the ACE school, was in the hospital & one of the grads from IBMP (Alvin) visited her and led her to the Lord. We started a new outreach at a medical clinic in Lumbia, close to the Church. Every Tuesday at 9 a.m. we go and sing songs, have testimony, and preaching. We had a lady named Alicia come to church now because of this ministry.

The Police Station Bible study is still going strong by the grace of God. Ken (a new IBMP student) and I were able to preach to some new police recruits. What an honor and a blessing. My path has crossed with some of these recruits again as they are assisting at the school crossings and other community services. Recently while at the High School, confirming the class time we will have starting June 19, two of these recruits were outside and I was able to encourage them again to believe on the Lord Jesus for salvation.

Summer here in Philippines usually means many of the children stop coming to church. We have seen this happen for a few years now and they usually come back once school starts. This year Anna started a Summer Reading program with some of the children to encourage them to read over the summer break. Some of those children she read books with ended up coming to church all summer with some of our regular children.
